Lima Refining Company / Husky Energy

Division of Surface Water

On May 7, 2015, a compliance evaluation inspection was conducted at the Lima Refining Company. No violations were noted at the time of the inspection.

Division of Materials and Waste Management

A hazardous waste compliance evaluation inspection was conducted on September 28, 2015. A Notice of Violation/ Return to Compliance letter was issued on November 18, 2015.

On November 10, 2015, Ohio EPA issued an Emergency Permit to Lima Refinery for the period of November 10, 2015 through December 11, 2015. The emergency permit allows the discharge and storage of D018 benzene contaminated waste waters into D-Pond in the event of a major rain event.

A class 1 permit modification was acknowledged on November 10, 2015. The permit modification included changes to the facility's letter of credit and financial assurance information as well as updated the post-closure and corrective action cost estimates for inflation.

A class 1 permit modification was acknowledged on November 10, 2015. The permit modification included changes to corrective action reporting frequency.

Ineos Nitriles USA LLC

Division of Air Pollution Control

A Title V air compliance inspection was conducted on November 10, 2015. No violations were noted at the time of the inspection.

On October 22, 2015 INEOS USA LLC submitted a letter notifying Ohio EPA of the facility's name change effective January 1, 2016. INEOS USA LLC is now named Ineos Nitriles USA LLC.

Division of Materials and Waste Management

A hazardous waste compliance evaluation inspection was conducted on August 12, 2015 and August 17, 2015. No violations were noted at the time of the inspection and a Notice of Compliance letter was issued on September 8, 2015.

A class 1 permit modification was acknowledged on November 10, 2015. The permit modification included changes to facility emergency contacts and updates to closure cost estimate and financial assurance for inflation.

INEOS Barex® USA LLC

This facility has been separated from the rest of Ineos Nitriles USA LLC, since the Barex® plant is now under separate ownership.

Division of Air Pollution Control

A Title V air compliance inspection was conducted on November 10, 2015. On November 24, 2015, an NOV was issued for failure to comply with a flow indicator or a lock bypass line as required by 40 CFR, Part 63, Subpart JJJ. The facility submitted a letter to U.S. EPA requesting approval for an alternative monitoring plan in order to correct the violation and return to compliance.

- An off-site Safety Summit was held on 12/16 which included Lima Management and the UAW Labor Committee; a
 joint 2016 Safety Plan was drafted.

The CEMS would have required dangerously high concentrations of H ₂ S (50%) in order to calibrate the instruments, which posed safety concerns from the manufacturing of the gas cylinders, the transportation of the cylinders, and potential exposure to employees and the community. The violations involved fluorescent lamp container with an open lid and no accumulation date, and a used oil container in the automotive shop with no label.
