- INEOS Lima incurred two recordable injuries in February: both incidents involved slips on ice and resulted in fractured elbow / arm.
- Husky Lima Refinery fire / explosion response that occurred in January will take the place of the Allen County
 combined drill this year.

Environmental:

- OSHA conducted a surprise site inspection on January 21. They requested information regarding safety, operations, inspection, environmental, PSM and instrumentation. OSHA returned for a follow-up visit on March 18 to discuss the February 11 AOGI outage and conduct interviews.
- On February 11 a power supply failure resulted in an AOGI and Acrylo 'B' turbine motor trip.
- Lima received an NOV / Return to Compliance from the Ohio EPA for a permit violation due to high injection pressure on #1 deep well February 20. This incident was weather related a frozen gauge.
- The new RefTek 130S seismic monitoring replacement station has been reviewed and approved by the Ohio EPA.
- A third party LDAR audit was conducted the week of March 9. The only findings were 2 OELs.

• A mini-PHA was conducted in January for Catalyst 59 and the new transport system to #1 calciner.
