Items presented/discussed — A public hearing for the Husky deepwell project is scheduled for April 20, 2017 with a comment period ending on April 24. — The hydrogen cyanide (HCN) emissions from the Husky FCC stack of 245 pounds per day (reported at the January ECAC meeting and discussed in lines 19 through 26 of the January 2017 ECAC minutes) has been confirmed and is still occurring. Still no ground-level detection. — Some "rotten-egg-odors" at Husky were traced to leaking seals on a centrifuge.
