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	<ul style="list-style-type: none">Husky (Paul Logsdon)<ul style="list-style-type: none">A printed report was distributed.The hydrocracker unit that structurally failed and was destroyed in the explosion of January 10, 2015 has been rebuilt. The new cracker is currently in the process of a slow startup. The rebuilt unit is fabricated from a different metal alloy that should not suffer from the embrittlement problem that occurred in the failed unit.	21
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	<ul style="list-style-type: none">PCS (Mike Resar)<ul style="list-style-type: none">A printed report was distributed.The printed report mentions an air inspection conducted on March 30, 2016, but it does not mention that the inspection resulted in an NOV for record-keeping violations. The NOV and resolution does appear in the OEPA report (see below).	28
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	<ul style="list-style-type: none">INEOS (Joe Bianco)<ul style="list-style-type: none">A printed report was distributed.The draft renewal permits for the four deepwells were received on June 21 and a public hearing was held on July 12. There were no comments or testimony by the attendees.Joe said that the deepwells are now on a 6-year inspection schedule.	34

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- **OEPA (Eric Getz)** 42
 - A printed report was distributed. 43
 - The printed report includes the NOV for PCS record keeping problems uncovered as a result of 44
the March 30 air inspection. The violations were corrected and OEPA issued a resolution of 45
violations letter on May 24. 46
 - Item #1 under the Division of Air Pollution Control for Husky Energy states that an NOV was 47
issued to Husky on July 6. Paul Logsdon stated this might not be an actual violation because it 48
appears a computational error was made. 49
 - Item #2 under the Division of Materials and Waste Management for Husky Energy describes a 50
complaint about oily residue on a concrete pad. This item should be removed from the OEPA 51
report for July 19 because it was already included in the April 19 OEPA report and was discussed 52
at the April 19 ECAC meeting. The item was inadvertently left in the document when the July 53
19 report was created. 54

Other Business: 56

- We intend to have the usual air monitoring report from OEPA at the October meeting. 57
- At this point we are assuming we will have the same schedule (quarterly meetings) for 2017. 58
- Mike Wildermuth suggested that it would be a good idea to create some “fact sheets” for the various 59
