## <sup>1</sup>MORTALITY

### Source:

Ohio Department of Health Vital Statistics Mortality Data, 2017

### Notes:

Data is presented for the top 5 leading causes of death and other causes of death among males and females. The number of deaths is presented for each cause of death as well as the Age-adjusted Death Rate (ADR).

Age-adjusted Death Rate gives the number of deaths per 100,000 population. This is a way to standardize death rates to minimize the effects of differences in age compositions when comparing the death rates for different populations (e.g. Allen County vs. Ohio).

## <sup>2</sup>MATERNAL & CHILD HEALTH

### Source:

Ohio Department of Health Vital Statistics Data, 2017, Analyzed by Allen County Public Health

### Notes:

Infant Mortality Rate is the number of deaths to infants under 1 year of age (364 days and younger) per 1,000 live births in a given year.

5-year average annual infant mortality rate is the total infant death rate average from 2013-2017. Rate is per 1,000 live births.

Teen Birth Rate is the number of births per 1,000 females ages 15-17 years.

Low Birth Weight Birth: A low birth weight birth is a birth of a baby who weighs less than 2,500 grams.

## <sup>3</sup>COMMUNICABLE DISEASE

Syphilis, Chlamydia, and Gonorrhea: Ohio Department of Health Sexually Transmitted Disease Data and Statistics, 2017

HIV/AIDS: Ohio Department of Health Surveillance Statistics, 2017

### Notes:

The incidence rate is reported for Syphilis (primary and secondary cases combined), Chlamydia, Gonorrhea, and the diagnosis of HIV infections.

The incidence rate is the number of new cases reported in a given year per 100,000 population. This information may include persons younger than 18 years of age.

## <sup>3</sup>COMMUNICABLE DISEASE continued

The prevalence rate is reported for persons living with HIV/AIDS. This represents all persons ever diagnosed and reported with HIV/AIDS who have not been reported as having died as of December 31, 2017. The rate is the number of person per 100,000 population.

## <sup>4</sup>UNHEALTHY BEHAVIORS & CONDITIONS

### Source:

Allen County Community Health Assessment, 2017

### Notes:

This community health assessment provides an overview of health-related data for Allen County adults (19 years and older) who participated in a county-wide health assessment survey during 2017.

Obesity in individuals is classified by body mass index (BMI), which is a measure of body fat based on height and weight.

Indicators are the percent of adults ages 19 and older reporting these behaviors and conditions.

## <sup>5</sup>INSURANCE STATUS

U.S Census Bureau, 2017 American Community Survey (ACS), 1 year estimates

### Notes:

Percent of adults ages 18-64 who are uninsured. Includes those in labor force, unemployed, and not in the labor force.
