HOME QUARANTINE AND SELF-MONITORING Instructions/Limitations

Your cooperation is necessary to protect yourself, your family, your community and the rest of the public.

Use these Quarantine instructions if:

- **1.** You have come into contact with a confirmed or probable positive case of COVID-19. **OR**
- **2.** You have recently traveled to a state or area that has been identified as having widespread, sustained (on-going) spread of COVID-19, and you have no symptoms of COVID-19.

You should self-quarantine and self-monitor for **fourteen (14) days** from your last point of contact or return from travel.

Comply with the following steps while self-quarantining at home:

- Stay Home: Stay home except to get medical care. Please call medical care facility before going.
- Separate Yourself: Try to stay at least 6 feet away from other household members and animals.
- **<u>Visitors</u>**: Limit visitors to those who have an essential need to be in your home.
- <u>Temperature and symptom monitoring</u>: You will self-monitor for fever and symptoms such as a cough, or difficulty breathing, for 14 days following your last day of potential exposure. Take your temperature with a thermometer two times a day, in the morning and evening.
- Warning Symptoms: If you develop new symptoms, immediately contact your health care provider. Symptoms include but are not limited to: high fever, shortness of breath, difficulty breathing, pain or tightness of chest, or blueish lips or face.
- Notification of Medical Personnel If it is necessary for you to contact police, fire or emergency medical services, you must notify the dispatcher and any first responder that you are under COVID-19 self-quarantine.
- <u>Discontinuing Self-Quarantine</u>: You can discontinue self-quarantine if no symptoms develop
 within fourteen (14) days since last point of contact with a confirmed or probable positive
 COVID-19 case or return from a state or area that has been identified as having widespread,
 sustained (on-going) spread of COVID-19.
