	Mandatory	<b>Recommended Best Practices</b>
Employees & Guests	<ul> <li>Ensure minimum 6 ft between people, if not possible, install barriers</li> <li>Face coverings are required while employers and employees are on the job, unless any one of the following apply: <ul> <li>An employee in a particular position is prohibited by a law or regulation from wearing a face covering while on the job</li> <li>A face covering is not advisable for health purposes</li> <li>Wearing a face covering on the job is against documented industry best practices</li> <li>Wearing a face covering violates a company's safety policies</li> <li>There is a practical reason a face covering cannot be worn</li> <li>An employees, written justification must be provided upon request.</li> </ul> </li> <li>Employees must perform daily symptom assessment*</li> <li>Require engular handwashing</li> <li>Place hand sanitizers in high-contact locations</li> <li>Clean high-touch items after each use (e.g. carts, baskets)</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>Ensure seating distance of 6 ft or more</li> <li>Customers and guests should wear a face covering. They are not required to wear a face covering.</li> <li>Enable natural workplace ventilation</li> <li>Health questionnaire for symptoms at entry</li> <li>Temperature taking protocol</li> </ul>
Physical Spaces / Workstations	<ul> <li>Frequent disinfection of desks, workstations, and high-contact surfaces</li> <li>Daily disinfection of common areas</li> <li>Cancel/postpone in person events when social distancing guidelines cannot be met</li> <li>No buffet in cafeteria</li> <li>Utilize disposable tableware and other materials</li> <li>Establish maximum capacity (e.g. 50% of fire code)</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>Redesign/space workstations for 6 ft or more of distance</li> <li>Close cafeteria and gathering spaces if possible, or conduct regular cleanings</li> <li>Limit congregation in office spaces</li> <li>Divide essential staff into groups and establishing rotating shift</li> <li>Availability of at least 3 weeks of cleaning supplies</li> </ul>
Confirmed Cases	<ul> <li>Immediately isolate and seek medical care for any individual who develops symptoms while at work</li> <li>Contact the local health district about suspected cases or exposures</li> <li>Shutdown shop/floor for deep sanitation if possible</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>Work with local health department to identify potentially infected or exposed individuals to help facilitate effective contact tracing/notifications</li> <li>Once testing is readily available, test all suspected infections or exposures</li> <li>Following testing, contact local health</li> </ul>
